Going Local: CABARRUS COUNTY

N.C. State's Plants for Human Health Institute (PHHI) consists of Research and Extension programs that create a dynamic presence at the Research Campus. PHHI's focus is research of fruits and vegetables that will enhance the health-protective value of food crops and have the potential to increase the economic impact of NC agriculture. Their mission is to lead the discovery and delivery of innovative plant-based solutions to advance human health. Youth will experience science lessons, taste tests, and a tour with career insight.

Going Local: GASTON COUNTY

On this trip, participants will visit the newest of Dole's four salad manufacturing plants. The Dole plant in Bessemer City averages more than 500,000 bags and trays daily. This facility packages 114 different salads using: iceberg; romaine; green cabbage; red cabbage; spinach; eight varieties of specialty lettuces; 13 varieties of tender leaf baby lettuces; carrots; radishes; tomatoes; snow peas; sugar snap peas. Dole Food Company as a whole is the world's largest producer of Fresh Fruits, Fresh Vegetables and Value Added Products. Dole is also leading the industry in nutritional education. Youth will view the manufacturing process while learning about value added food, nutrition, and the science within.
